<p>Cllr Barker enquired when Officers will be advertising the community centre for hire, (new facility and general facility).</p>	<p>The hall has been marketed for hire that meets the current COVID19 restrictions and both existing hirers the waiting list of new hirers that meet this guidance are arranging bookings. Once the restrictions have been lifted fully to allow parties full marketing will commence.</p>
<p>Cllr Kirk asked if there was an event planned for the opening of the new hall, it was also suggested that councillors may wish to see the new hall before opening.</p>	<p>The official opening is on the agenda and councillors can liaise with the clerk regarding a viewing.</p>
<p>Cllr Kirk asked what the position was regarding a proposed outdoor gym.</p>	<p>Councillors were considering one at the Anson Avenue play area however the level of the current workload has not permitted this to be progressed.</p>
<p>Cllr Kirk asked if there was a plan to look at the deficit of bookings for the community centre, due to the pandemic.</p>	<p>This is addressed in the year-end report.</p>
<p>Cllr Kirk asked if the replacement of the 3G crumb has been budgeted for in 2021.</p>	<p>KHPC shall cover the final crumb payment for this season and tactive shall be responsible for the crumb after this. There is no budget in 2021/22 for this however the income</p>

	for the 3G and pitch hire is expected to cover these costs.
