Decision Required: To note answers to councillors questions

Cllr Barker asked if there was now a need to promote the vacant allotments.	The allotments had not been promoted due to the national lockdown and the need for essential journeys only. Once restrictions are lifted the allotments will be promoted.
Cllr Barker asked when the Amenities will be considering the name of the new hall and the process for the official opening.	The naming of the hall is on the March agenda for the Amenities Committee. The opening shall be considered once the next set of national restrictions are confirmed on 6 th April 2021.
Cllr Barker asked whether the new hall will be included in the fire risk assessment.	When an extension is added a new fire risk assessment has to be carried out. This has been undertaken.
Cllr Barker stated that she would like to ensure that the testing of the fire alarm is undertaken once the facility is re-opened.	This is a legal requirement and undertaken by the Chief Facility Officer every 6 months.
