REFRESH FOR THE COMMUNITY CENTRE LOBBY

Kings Hill Parish Council has received a generous £4,000 National Lottery support to help towards replacing the tired and damaged community centre lobby flooring.

Since the Covid-19 pandemic and lockdown began Kings Hill Parish Council has had to close its facilities meaning no income during these lockdown periods. The team has spent time refreshing the community centre by painting and decorating with what equipment we already had but were lacking funds to replace the carpet, which was beyond repair.

With this grant we are able to dispose of the worn out, ripped carpet and replace with a hard wearing Altro non-slip vinyl all the way through the lobby areas which will be much easier to maintain and keep clean. The real bonus for us is that it matches the new extension work, funded by Liberty Property Trust, so will give the centre an all-round fresh new look.

Cllr Sarah Barker, Chairman of Kings Hill Parish Council said: "Thanks to the National Lottery Community Fund we can now replace this part of the flooring to make it connect to the brand new hall that has been built. We are grateful that The National Lottery is supporting us at this crucial time."

The UK-wide fund aimed to address both immediate emergency actions and help organisations to start thinking about recovery.
